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Experience Divine Acceleration and Unstoppable Momentum

Mom Wanda Bragg, ran across the following article from Jerry Savelle that confirmed the Word of the Lord for our 2024 journey. It reads as follows:]

I know what it's like to wait for an answer to prayer. There's been times I've wondered, "How long is it going to take, when will my breakthrough come?" Over the years, I've learned that seeing God's miraculous power requires patience and a no-quit attitude.

During my time with the Lord this past October, He told me to expect to experience the open hand of God that will bring supernatural, extraordinary, and unusual provision to those who will not be shaken by all the chaos and disorder. If you're committed to sticking it out and refuse to be shaken, you will see God's provision in supernatural ways.

He also said to me that it would be a **time of divine acceleration and unstoppable momentum!** The Psalmist proclaimed, "The Lord upholds all who fall and lifts up all who are bowed down. The eyes of all look to you, and you give them their food at the proper time. You open your hand and satisfy the desires of every living thing" (Psalm 145:14-16 NIV).

I'm here to tell you, the time has come. Don't quit or be shaken before you see it. Over the past fifty-three years of ministry, I've seen many believers give up before "the proper time." They weren't willing to stick it out and yet, I've stood in faith for as long as twenty years for something to happen and God came through.

It has been said that **Divine Acceleration** is the supernatural ability of God to bring His plans, His purposes, and His will to pass at a much faster rate than is humanly possible.

When God decides that it's time for something to come to pass, then nothing can stop Him from making it happen. There's a phrase in the Bible to which you need to pay closer attention to. Paul wrote to the believers in Galatia about God's timing declaring, "But when the fullness of time was come..."

(Galatians 4:4). The Amplified translation states, "When the proper time had fully come..."

Obviously, Paul is referring to the time for Jesus to come into the earth and fulfill what His God-given assignment required (Hebrews 2:9 "Jesus...who should taste death for every man"). When that time had fully come, no man nor devil could stop Jesus' assignment. The date had been set by God, and when all the requirements had been fulfilled, Jesus went to the cross, shed His blood and died, and then was raised from the dead. What God had promised would now become reality...redemption, salvation, and victory over sin.

I declare to you today, you're headed for another "fullness of time," and what God has planned, Satan won't be able to stop. God's open hand is extended toward you and you're entering a time of divine acceleration and unstoppable momentum!

The economy can't stop God's plan for you. No government can stop your breakthrough. Sickness and disease have no power to block God's purpose for you. Lack and insufficiency will not alter the assignment that God has for you. God alone is in charge of the "times and the seasons" (Daniel 2:21). When God says it's time for something to happen, then you can count on it, it will happen.

And don't let the chaos and disorder of this world weaken your faith. Paul tells you, "This know also that in the last days perilous times shall come" (2 Timothy 3:1). Don't be surprised when troubles and hardships surround you.

But at the same time, we don't have to be shaken by them! Paul went on to tell you how to respond to them, "Don't let it phase you; stick with what you've learned and believed..." (2 Timothy 3:14 MSG).

It's much like what Jesus told His disciples when they asked Him about the signs of the end. He told them about all the evil things that would be happening. Then He makes this remarkable statement, "...see that ye be not troubled, for all these things must come to pass but the end is not yet" (Matthew 24:6).

What's this mean for you? Jesus is saying it's possible to live in a world filled with trouble and yet not be troubled by it.

We see this principle also revealed in the Old Testament. The Prophet Isaiah proclaimed, "See, darkness covers the earth and thick darkness is over the peoples, but the Lord rises upon you and his glory appears over you" (Isaiah 60:2).

God is telling us that when the world is getting darker and darker, the Church will get brighter and brighter.

This year you will see chaos and disorder around you, but God has got you covered! When God is at work, nothing can stop Him. When he says it's time for divine acceleration and unstoppable momentum, then get ready for it. Look for it, watch for it, and expect it!

This doesn't mean that you won't have to use your faith any longer, but it does mean that it's just not going to take as long for the things that you are believing for to happen.

God is going to remove hindrances and obstacles that have prevented you from possessing that for which you've been believing. And I declare over you that things are going to begin to happen so rapidly that it will amaze you.

This is where you're headed, the unstoppable momentum has already begun. You're being positioned by God right now for divine acceleration! When you're in the season of divine acceleration, you'll experience more and more "suddenlies" in your life. It's going to happen so fast that it's going to surprise you. We've seen this happen before in Scripture: "And Hezekiah rejoiced and all the people that God had prepared...for the thing was done suddenly" (2 Chronicles 29:36).

Get ready for a supernatural surge and a supernatural moving forward.

Take hold of this right now and refuse to give up, this is not the time for you to turn back. Divine acceleration and unstoppable momentum are headed your way! Expect this, talk about it continually, and praise God in advance for it.

"Create in me a new, clean heart, O God, filled with clean thoughts and right desires."

Psalms 51:10

The first seven days of this 14-day journey will focus on a time of personal restoration. The Bible cites us all with the indictment that "we've all sinned and fallen short of God's glory" (Romans 3:23.) None of us are individually good or perfect apart from Christ, leaving us all at the mercy of God as we come clean with every spot and wrinkle that has silently stained our garments, pulling us progressively away from God and thus the presence and power of His Kingdom.

In addition, this week will attack every form of self-righteousness that has convinced us of being alright, comparing ourselves to those who we've deemed as not alright. One of the greatest sins that require radical reformation is the sin of self-righteousness. This sin is subtle and convinces us that we're in proper fellowship with God, while all along we're just as far away (or farther) than the rankest of sinners who have no problem admitting their sinful state and dire need for God.

This week we will get rid of the "junk in the trunk". We can't expect God to fill us with more of Him when He finds us full of ourselves.

By the end of this first week, the spirit and fruit of humility will actively reign in your lives, positioning you to receive from God in an accelerated fashion without distractions or hindrances. You are now ready to receive the "unstoppable momentum" of impartation of Holy Spirit as you journey into week 2.

When we free ourselves from the other voices and distractions that have led us astray, we can clearly hear the voice of the Lord who desires to get us back on track, allowing us to fully trust again. (Proverbs 3:5-6)

This first week is the preparation for the shift from the brake to the accelerator. Get ready to accelerate to higher heights in Christ!

Week 1/Day 7: RESTORE

"Father, I pray for the healing of past wounds and traumas that slow down my progress, releasing me into a season of joy and fulfillment."

Impartation: To give, bestow, reveal, make known!

"Neglect not the gift that is in thee, which was given thee by prophecy, with the laying on of the hands of the presbytery [body of elders.] **1 Tim 4:14**

The second week of your 14-day journey will focus on being refilled after being spiritually detoxified. The 7 days of reformation has now made room for you to receive the impartation of spiritual gifts, prophetic instruction, empowerment, and divine direction for the journey ahead. You have now given the Holy Spirit your undivided attention and have been spiritually sensitized to receiving from God without reservations or distractions.

Your spiritual walk and service to the Kingdom will produce great fruit. Many Kingdom fringe benefits that have been stored up for you are now being made available to you. This is the week where you are now lighter on your feet and in a better position to chase after God, desiring the government of God to become activated in your life. Your motivation for the illumination of the Kingdom in your life is no longer contingent on the "things" you will receive from God, but more so from the joy and peace of an intense fellowship that is now forming in your life which greatly pleases God and satisfies your inner man. This is the season where you and God carry the same agenda. You're no longer chasing "things", rather you're consumed with chasing after God and the things of God. The fruit of this new pursuit are the "accelerated" blessings of God being released without notice concerning those things that have concerned you, while you're deeply concerned with the things that concern Him.

It's now up to you to make it a lifestyle and not an event. Savor the moment and hold fast to your renewed faith in Christ. Be prepared to receive a word of wisdom, knowledge, and direction from God. It is God's will that you know the plans He has in store for you. Expect prophetic insights and direction to flow on the daily Prayer Line. Be sure to journal what you hear the Holy Spirit speaking expressly to you.

Get ready to experience **Divine Acceleration and Unstoppable Momentum!** Look for it! Expect it! It's already happening!

Week 2/Day 8: SPIRITUAL FRUIT

"Lord, teach me to yield to your Spirit, guiding me in the direction of your wind and divine pathway (Psalm 25:12, KJV)."

Week 2/Day 9: FAITH

Impartation: To give, bestow, reveal, make known!

Week 2/Day 12: BOLDNESS

Requiring or exhibiting courage and bravery.

(Psalms 138:3, Proverbs 28:1, Acts 4:29-30, 14:3, 19:8, Philippians 1:14, 1 Thessalonians 2:2, Ephesians 6:19-20, Hebrews 13:6)

"Lord, I pray for the grace to be strong and of good courage, not fearing nor being afraid of them; for the Lord my God, He is the One who goes with me. He will not leave me nor forsake me (Deuteronomy 31:6)."

Impartation: To give, bestow, reveal, make known!

"Neglect not the gift that is in thee, which was given thee by prophecy, with the laying on of the hands of the presbytery [body of elders.]" 1 Tim 4:14

Week 2/Day 13: POWER

Authority or capacity to act that is delegated by God; the ability or capacity to perform or act effectively.

(Matthew 9:8, 10:1, Mark 3:15, 6:7, Luke 9:1, 10:19, 24:49, Acts 1:8, 4:33, 6:8, Romans 1:16, 1 Corinthians 2:4, 4:20, 2 Corinthians 4:7, Ephesians 3:20, Philippians 3:10, 2 Timothy 1:7, 3:5, Revelations 2:26)

"Father, I ask for the grace to be strong in the Lord and the power of your might, putting on the whole armor of God to stand against the wiles of the devil (Ephesians 6:10-11)."

Impartation: To give, bestow, reveal, make known!

Week 2/Day 14: AUTHORITY

The power to enforce laws, exact obedience, command, determine or judge.

(Luke 9:1, 10:19, Romans 13:1)

"Lord, grant me the discernment to recognize the opportunities you have placed before me, helping me to seize them with courage and wisdom."

ABOUT YOUR JOURNEY

The next 14-day journey will consist of the following:

- Two Week Focus. The first 7 days will focus on Reformation (a week of repentance and personal cleansing.) The second 7 days will focus on Impartation (a week of receiving, believing, and expecting.)
- 2. Daily Fasting. There are several kinds of Fasts that you can choose to follow throughout the 14 days. We would recommend the "Daniel Fast" which is explained in detail in a later chapter. The Daniel Fast basically consists of fruits, vegetables, water, or fruit juice. This type of fast provides a greater success of participation by a sizable corporate church or group. Individuals or smaller groups may opt to go with a water only or water and juice fast. For water and juice only fasts lasting over 3 days, we would highly recommend you do so under a doctor's release. The goal of fasting during this 14-day journey is not to break the fast until you've completed the 14th day. Fasting is designed to weaken the flesh man and strengthen the spirit man.
- 3. Daily Prayer. A minimum of two hours each day should be committed to prayer and meditation. One hour at the start of the day and one hour in the evening is recommended. This time may be adjusted to coincide with 2nd and 3rd shift work schedules and other extenuating circumstances. It is extremely difficult to pursue and possess the Kingdom without a regular conversation and fellowship with the King. Daily prayer will be offered twice daily on the Prayer Line 6:30am-7:30am and 6:30pm-7:30pm every day. Make prayer a priority of your day! Call (425) 585-7215 (No special passcode needed).
- 4. Daily Meditation and Journaling. During and following prayer, listen intently for the voice and direction of the Holy Spirit. He often speaks from within you, through other people, as well as through daily events, Bible studies, sermons, or other vehicles. Keep this journal and a pen close by to record what you hear the Holy Spirit saying to you. You may receive a directive to ask forgiveness, seek reconciliation, or some other instruction to prepare you to go deeper. Trust and obey! It's your road to an awesome encounter with God.
- 5. Record and Celebrate. Over the 14 day journey and throughout the year, be sure to acknowledge (write down) the hope that God is resurrecting in your life. As hope becomes reality, it's time to take a "praise break" and celebrate the fulfillment of each. Keep in mind that every hope may not happen within a 12 month period, but the Lord will sometimes present you with nuggets that confirm you're on the right track. Celebrate those nuggets as well!
- 6. **Sow & Accelerate!** The harvest never happens without a seed. Get ready to plant a seed into this season of consecration for acceleration!

THE DANIEL FAST

Question: "What is a Daniel fast?"

Answer: The concept of a Daniel fast comes from Daniel 1:8-14, "But Daniel resolved not to defile himself with the royal food and wine, and he asked the chief official for permission not to defile himself this way. Now God had caused the official to show favor and sympathy to Daniel, but the official told Daniel, 'I am afraid of my lord the king, who has assigned your food and drink. Why should he see you looking worse than the other young men your age? The king would then have my head because of you.'

Daniel then said to the guard whom the chief official had appointed over Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael and Azariah, 'Please test your servants for ten days: Give us nothing but vegetables to eat and water to drink. Then compare our appearance with that of the young men who eat the royal food and treat your servants in accordance with what you see.' So he agreed to this and tested them for ten days." The background of the Daniel fast is that Daniel and his three friends had been deported to Babylon when Nebuchadnezzar and the Babylonians conquered Judah (2 Kings 24:13-14). Daniel and his three friends were put into the Babylonian court servant "training program." Part of the program was learning Babylonian customs, beliefs, laws, and practices. The eating habits of the Babylonians were not in complete agreement with the Mosaic Law. As a result, Daniel asked if he and his three friends could be excused from eating the meat (which was likely sacrificed to Babylonian false gods and idols). So, a Daniel fast is eating only fruits and vegetables for a certain amount of time and abstaining from meat products. Some people use a Daniel fast as a dieting method. Some people use a Daniel fast instead of fasting from food entirely. The Bible nowhere commands believers to observe a Daniel fast. As a result, it is a matter of Christian freedom whether to observe a Daniel fast.

There are many different versions of what has become known as the "Daniel Fast". What is more important is your commitment to God during this time. Ideally, one should do without the following: No animal products, sugar, caffeine, alcohol. To get a bit more specific this means absolutely No Meat, Milk, Fish, Fried Foods, Butter and Margarine, Shortening, White Flour, Preservatives and Additives, Refined Sugar (high fructose corn syrup, etc.) Sugar Substitutes (Nutrasweet, etc.), Caffeine (coffee, black tea, green tea, white tea) and Alcohol (Beer, wine, etc.

ORGANIC FOODS TO EAT DURING THE DANIEL FAST:
